

Year 4 Autumn 1 Home Learning Tasks

This term we have an exciting start to year 4. We will be learning about writing a short story from the 'Paperbag Prince' in our English sequence. We will be looking at place value as we build our maths knowledge. As scientists, we will be learning about solids and liquids. As Historians, we will be exploring the world of the Romans. As Geographers, we will be learning about the River Rhine. In RE, we will learn about Christianity through stories. In Computing, we will be learning about the Internet and build our understanding of Gymnastics and Rugby skills in PE. Our PE days will be Tuesdays and Fridays (Hares) and Wednesdays and Fridays (Otters). Please ensure that your child wears their PE kit to school on these days each week. Your children will receive a homework book and can choose to complete any tasks from the grid below, these are usually **due on a Wednesday** so that home learning can be shared by the end of the week. We also welcome you to share home learning via pictures and videos on Class Dojo. During the first couple of weeks, your child will complete an accelerated reading star quiz and bring home a book to read with an assigned ZPD. Children will also be bringing home reading for pleasure books that may be beyond their own reading level so please share these and enjoy reading together. The ZPD book must be read and discussed before your child can complete a quiz in school. We ask children to read 5 times a week at home to an adult and ask that this is recorded in their reading record which needs to come to school with their reading book every day as we will have daily in class reading time. Each week you can choose one or two activities from the grid below. Please continue to enjoy plenty of reading and times tables practise (recap) of the 2,5,10 times tables and then 3 x and 6.
